Spot treatment is defined as a treatment area no greater than For St. Augustinegrass, Bentgrass, Buffalograss and 1,000 sq. ft. per acre. The maximum application rate is 5.0 fl. Centipedegrass: oz. per 1.000 sq. ft. per application.

The maximum number of spot treatment applications is 2 per year with a minimum of 30 days between applications.

Broadcast Treatments

FOR ORTHO HOSE-END SPRAYERS. For St. Augustinegrass, Bentgrass, Buffalograss And Centipedegrass:

- For Tank sprayers: Use 1/2 fl. oz. (1Tbs.) per 1 gallon of water to cover 200 sq. ft. of lawn.
- For the Dial 'N Spray Hose-End Sprayer: Measure 2.5 fl. oz. (5 Tbs.) into sprayer iar for every 1.000 sq. ft of lawn. Do not add water to jar. Set dial to 1 Tbs. and spray.

HOW MUCH TO USE: Spot treatments:

For Tank sprayers - Use 1/2 fluid ounce (1 Tablespoon) per gallon of water to cover 200 square feet of lawn. Do not use on Floratam or other improved varieties of St.

Do not apply to St. Augustinegrass or centipedegrass emerging from winter dormancy. Temperatures below 45°F within 72 hours of application may cause damage.

For Bluegrass, Fescues, Perennial Ryegrass, Bahiagrass, Bermudagrass and Zoysiagrass: Use 1 fluid ounce (2 Tablespoons) per gallon of water to cover 200 square feet.

Repeat treatment for hard-to-control weeds in 30 days if they regrow. Do not use a hose end sprayer to spray small areas or spot treat weeds.
