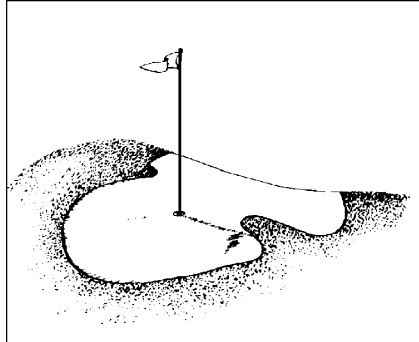


BLUE COLORANT

**BLUE COLORANT
DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

HAND SPRAYERS: Use 1 Tablespoonful per gallon of water (2 oz. per 4 gallons of water).

POWER SPRAYERS: For large area broadcast applicators use the amount given in the following table:

GALLONS OF WATER PER ACRE	RATE OF BLUE COLORANT PER 100 GALLONS OF SPRAY		
	LOW	MEDIUM	HIGH
25	1 QT.	2 QT.	4 QT.
50	1 PT.	1 QT.	2 QT.
100	8 oz.	1 PT.	1 QT.

(Approximately 1/4 to 3/4 oz. per 1000 sq. ft.)

GREENHOUSE FERTILIZER INJECTORS:

Use the amounts of BLUE COLORANT in injector concentrate tank as given below:

Injector Ratio	Amount Blue Colorant Per		
	Gallon	10 Gallons	100 Gallons
1:300	1.5 oz.	15 oz.	5 QT.
1:200	1 oz.	10 oz.	3 QT.
1:150	.75 oz.	7.5 oz.	2.33 QT.
1:128	.66 oz.	6.5 oz.	2 QT.
1:100	.5 oz.	5 oz.	3 PT.
1:50	1 TBLS.	2.5 oz.	1.5 PT.

NOTE: Rates given in both spray application and injector sections are intended as an initial application guide only. Greater or lesser amounts may be indicated depending on color or density of vegetation or by preference of the operator.

FIRST AID INFORMATION
