DRY APPLICATION TO VEGETABLES AND ORNAMENTALS:

AT OR BEFORE PLANTING: 5 Lbs. per 200 square feet. Mix thoroughly with the soil before planting. **VEGETABLES:** Apply at above rate. Four to six weeks after planting, side-dress with 1 lb. per 50 linear feet of row. Water thoroughly.

BULBS OR SMALL PLANTS: For deep color mix several tablespoonfuls with soil before planting. Set the bulb into place and cover with soil. Water thoroughly.

IRIS, CRAPE MYRTLE, LILACS, PEONIES: Should have an application of Superphosphate in early spring to strengthen stems and increase blooms. Use a light covering on ground six inches away from stems. Work into soil. **CHRYSANTHEMUMS and DAHLIAS:** Use a sprinkling of Triple Superphosphate dug in lightly, as not to disturb roots near the surface.

ROSES and SHRUBS: Use 1/4 cup per plant. When planting, mix with soil used to fill around roots. For established plants, mix lightly into soil around plants. Avoid contact with stems. Water thoroughly.

FRUIT TREES: For each inch of trunk diameter apply 1 cup evenly under the canopy and slightly beyond. Apply in early spring or late fall.

TOP DRESSING EXISTING PLANTS: Use 1/4 to 1/2 cup per 20 square feet of area and work lightly into soil.
